Please forward a copy of the Fact Finding Committee's Memorandum of Disposition to the Review Committee once completed so that we may close our file on this case.



Subject of the Grievance

This grievance concerns the use of crew readily available to perform an emergency overtime assignment rather than calling in a crew from the Title 212 overtime list.

The correction requested by the Union was that the Company pay grievants all wages and benefits lost as a result of company's action in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement.

Discussion

The Committee discussed the sequence of events relating to the time the emergency call came in and the availability of the crew that had just completed a prearranged overtime assignment in relation the to time it would take to compile a crew from the emergency overtime list. The Committee discussed the fact that is was impractical to call an emergency crew from the overtime list when a crew was readily available to perform the assignment.

Decision

The Committee agreed that the case be settled without adjustment pursuant to Subsection 212.11(a). In arriving at it's decision, the Committee also relied on Pre-Review Committee Decision 779.

On this basis, the case is closed.
