Subject of the Grievance

This grievance alleges a violation of Exhibit XVI, Contracting Out.

Facts of the Case

This grievance was filed on behalf of a Title 200 Materials Handler, currently Lead Driver, in Fresno alleging that this is work that should be performed by the grievant and that very little overtime has been offered in the Materials Department.

There has been a Grid (Transmission - T300) warehouse in Fresno since at least 1981. Electricians and Station Mechanics regularly delivered materials and supplies to Grid Maintenance job sites. Beginning early 2000, the Materials Department began ordering, receiving and storing materials for Grid. However, Grid retained jurisdiction for delivery materials to their job sites, which it then contracted. Grid did not complete and submit the requisite Notice of Intent to contract form.

The Local Investigating Committee report is clear that prior to February 2000 none of this work was performed by Materials for Grid.

Decision

The Company agrees that if this work continues to be contracted, it will provide Union with the Notice of Intent to Contract and report the contracted hours in the Station, Substation, and Hydro Department.

This case is closed on the basis of the foregoing.
