Gentlemen:

During the recently concluded negotiations regarding the consolidation of Plant and Pipeline Maintenance Crews in Pipe Line Operations, no specific mention was made of a possible change of work headquarters for employees shown in the Agreement at the Tracy-Brentwood or at the Topock-Needles location. However, part of the consolidation process includes the reporting of crews for these locations at Tracy and at Topock. In fact, this has been going on since November 15, 1971.

As a result, it is Company's intent to place employees displaced by the discontinuance of the Brentwood or Needles headquarters into an appropriate classification in accordance with provisions of Title 206 of the Physical Agreement.
