Dear Mr. Bonbright:

The attached Letter Agreement, 81-6-PGE, has been signed and is being returned to you with the following understandings:

- 1. The employees being considered for initially staffing the Decoto Pipeyard "assembly center" will be selected from those people who are currently on L.T.D., Workmen's Compensation payroll, or Light Duty status involving both industrial and non-industrial disabilities. The selection of employees will, notwithstanding the Letter Agreement, be from both electrical and non-electrical background.
- 2. The employees will retain their regular classification and be paid at the appropriate current rate of pay.
- 3. Should the employees have to return to their former status, for whatever reason, they shall do so pursuant the applicable provisions of the current Labor and/or Benefit Agreements.
- 4. Item No. 3 of the Letter Agreement will be modified to the extent that this work will not be performed at the Decoto "assembly center" but will, instead, be done at the Company's Emeryville Materials Distribution Center.
