Re: Title 205 Application

Letter agreement number 90-69 allowed PG&E to establish line crews in various locations throughout the system that would be primarily dedicated to performing transmission work. Agreement was necessary due to the application of filling these position in locations where line crews already existed and to address Titles 208 and 212 issues.

The agreement provided, in part, (1) these crews would remain in the electric T&D department, and (2) employees in the affected region could be "b" bidders into these positions.

Recently questions have been asked if employees who bid to transmission crews have "b" bidding rights <u>from</u> transmission crews to other positions in the region as opposed to the bidding unit. The answer is "nope".

After some discussion of this application in Sacramento Valley Region, 1245 and PG&E have agreed that the only exception to be applied is bidding into a transmission crew. The intent was to expand our members opportunities to transmission crews since they were being established on a limited basis, however, it is not intended to allow employees to "leap frog" over bidding unit boundaries at the expense of other employees.

Employees on transmission crews are considered to be 'b' bidders within the bidding unit that their regular headquarters is located.
