Recognizing Ed Beoshanz for Exemplary Service to the County of Yolo

WHEREAS, Ed Beoshanz is a life-long Yolo County resident whose family settled here in 1869; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Beoshanz grew up in Plainfield, attended the Fairfield School, and joined the West Plainfield Fire Protection District as a firefighter at age 18; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Beoshanz served on the West Plainfield Fire Protection District his entire adult life, holding the positions of Firefighter, Fire Captain, and multiple leadership positions as a Commissioner of the West Plainfield Fire Protection District, until his retirement in 2021; and

WHEREAS, the original West Plainfield Fire House was located on the Beoshanz family property until being moved to its current location on County Road 95; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Beoshanz also worked for Pacific Gas and Electric in Davis and retired as their chief mechanic; and

WHEREAS, the Beoshanz family has had multiple generations of West Plainfield firefighters, including Ed's father, son, and grandson; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Beoshanz's heart and soul belong to his community, friends, and neighbors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors expresses sincere appreciation and gratitude of Ed Beoshanz for his many years of dedicated service to the West Plainfield Fire Protection District and wish him a long, healthy, and happy future.
