Title 6 – Working Hours

Title 6 Working Hours

6.8 (a)(1)

Company may change employee(s) start time no more than three (3) two (2) times in a calendar year. When Company changes employee's start time back to regular start time, it will not count as a change. If split start times are used, equalization of conditions and rotation of assignments will occur. Such rotations for equalization shall not be considered as a change in schedule.

Example:

08:00 AM is the current start time. If the current start time is changed to 09:00AM, that constitutes as one change. Changing the start time back from 9:00AM to the original start time of 08:00AM does not constitute as an additional change. This example counts as a single start time change. 08:00AM to 09:00AM, then back to 08:00AM is one change. *

Example:

08:00 AM is the current start time. If the current start time is changed to 09:00AM, that constitutes as one change. Changing the start time from 09:00AM to 10:00AM constitutes as an additional change. Changing the start time back from 10:00AM to the original start time of 08:00AM does not constitute as a change. This example counts as two start time changes. 08:00AM to 09:00AM, then 09:00 to 10:00AM and then back to 08:00AM is two changes. *

*08:00AM is the original start time. Converting back to the original start time does not constitute as a change.
